- Notes:
- Standard terms are two-years, with a maximum of three consecutive terms.
 - In order to achieve offset terms between co-chairs of the same subcommittee, the Board of Directors has approved one-time changes to certain co-chair terms (1-year or 3-year terms).
 - Each fall, nominations are received within each subcommittee for any open co-chair positions (terms that will be completed by the end of that December). All nominations are confirmed by the Board of Directors in January.
 - Terms commence January 1 and end on December 31. For example, a two-year term of 2019 and 2020 commences on January 1, 2019 and ends on December 31, 2020.
 - The timeline shows the status of all co-chairs. "End" signifies the maximum term possible for each co-chair.
